



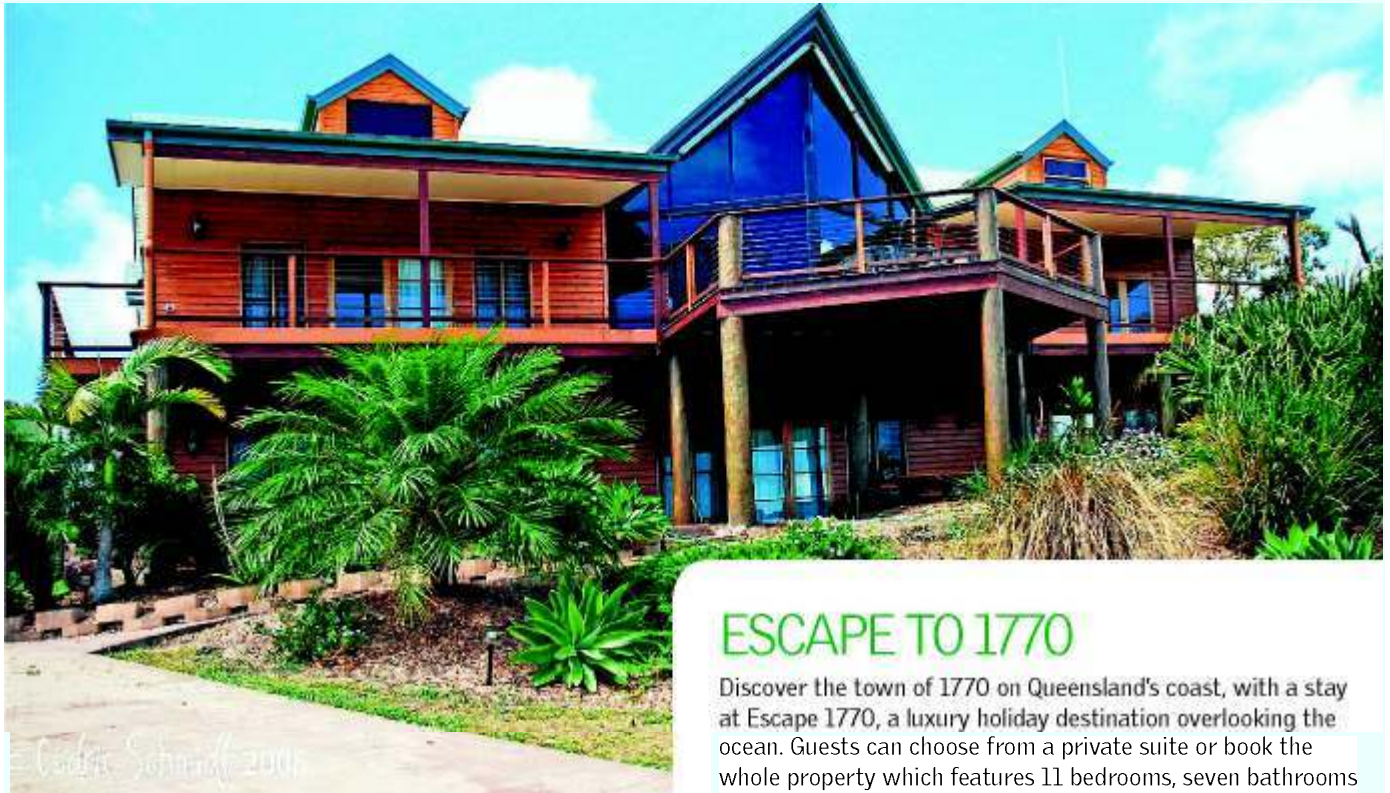

ESCAPE TO 1770

Discover the town of 1770 on Queensland's coast, with a stay at Escape 1770, a luxury holiday destination overlooking the ocean. Guests can choose from a private suite or book the whole property which features 11 bedrooms, seven bathrooms and four studio suites with living rooms. The main suite includes three bedrooms, living room and modern kitchen and each suite is equipped with a spa bathroom and terraces with ocean views across the Coral Sea. There also is a private poolside and entertaining pavilion, big outdoor kitchen area and a barn which is perfect for a big party or wedding. Using 1770 as a base, visitors can explore the Great Barrier Reef or take part in activities including fishing, amphibian rides, scooter tours, four-wheel-driving or surfing. Escape 1770 rates are \$500 for two nights per suite sleeping four; \$2500 per week for half the house sleeping 12 or \$2700 per weekend for the entire property, which sleeps 22. Travellers looking for a private hideaway will find just the place at Sunset Villa beach cottage, a two-level timber house overlooking the waters of the 1770 estuary. The cottage has a covered deck area with barbecue, TV lounge area, open-plan, air-conditioned king-sized room and one single. The downstairs area has another big open-plan air-conditioned room with five single beds, making the cottage ideal for a family or a retreat for honeymooners.
